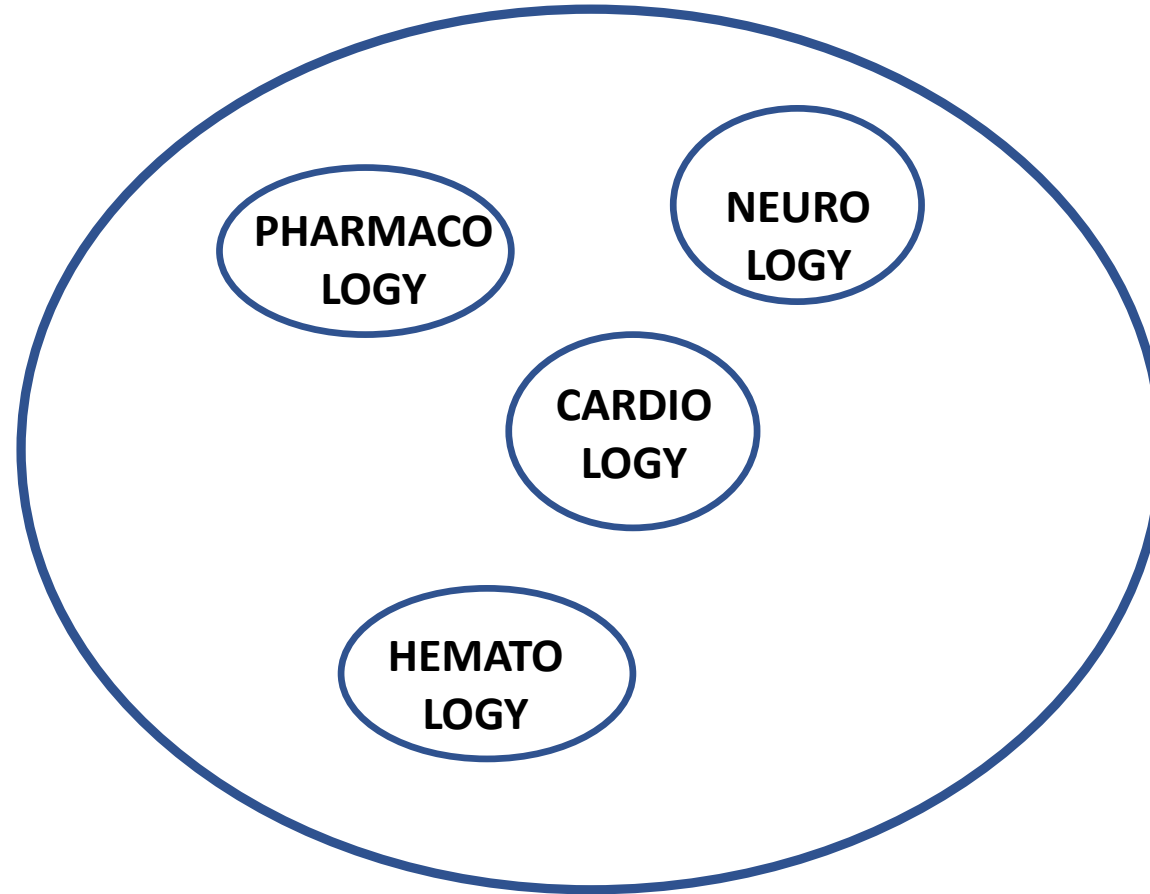

- **Crossdisciplinary:** Viewing one discipline from perspective of others.

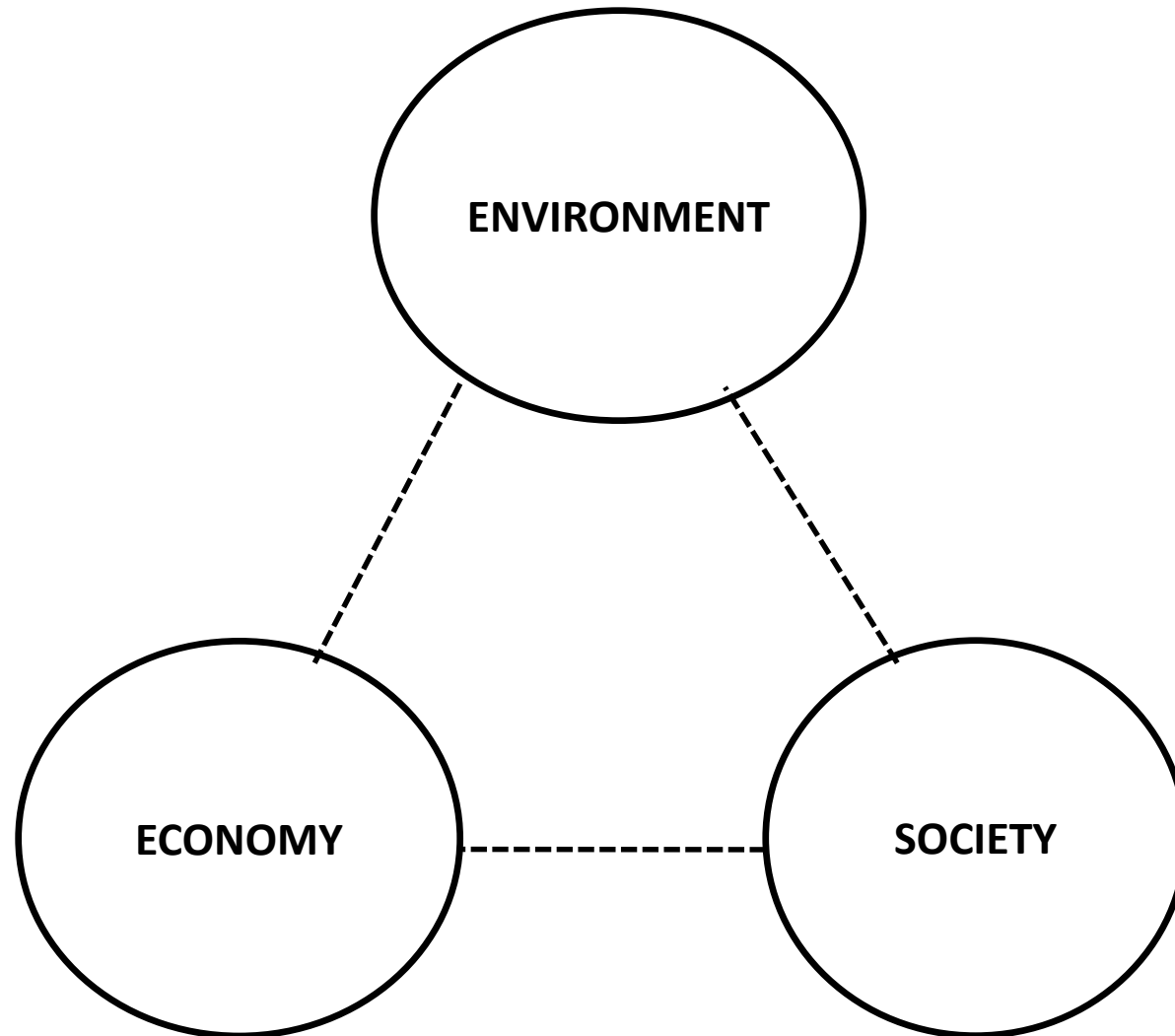
INTRADISCIPLINARITY

Intradisciplinary: Working within a single discipline.



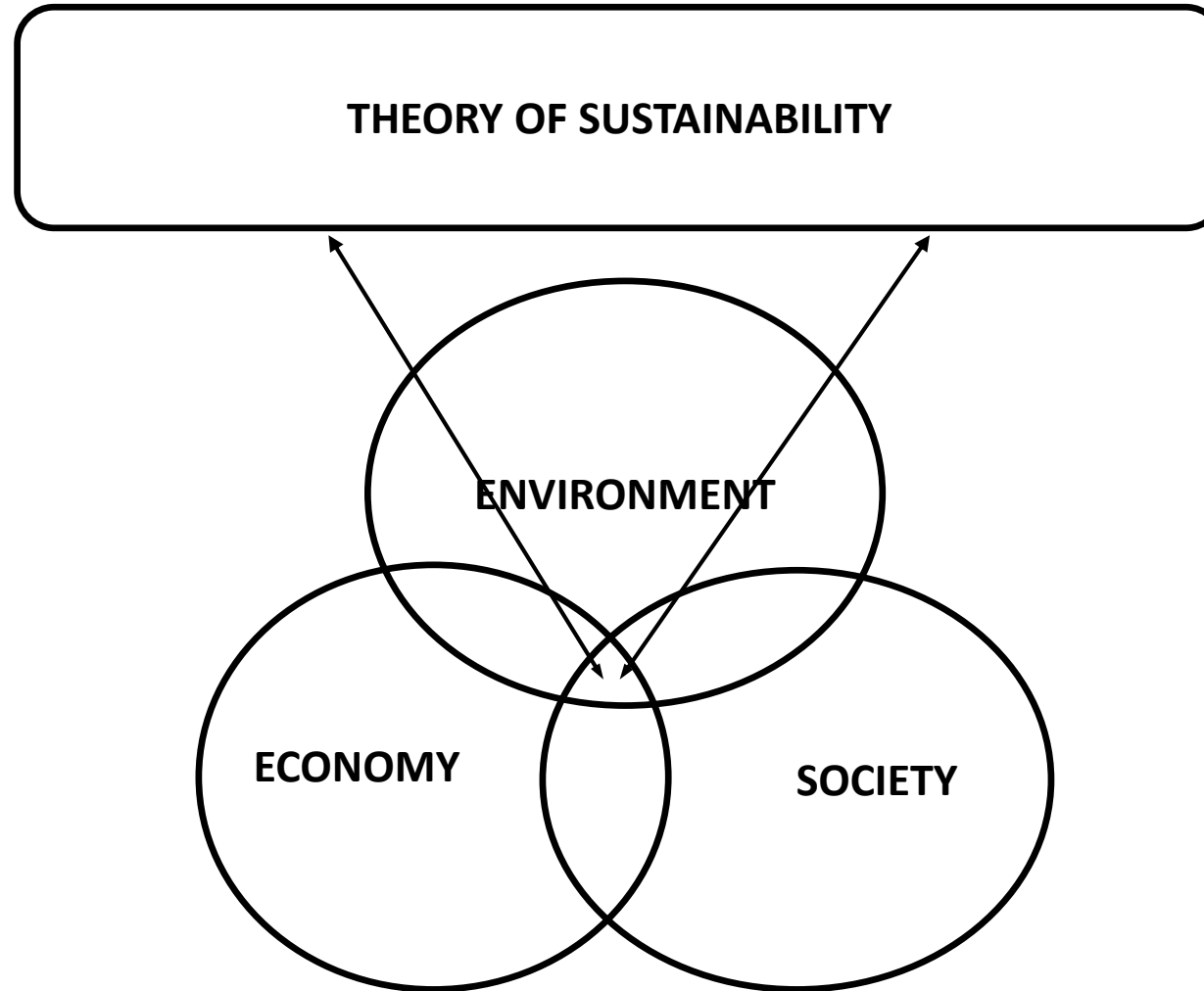
MULTIDISCIPLINARY

Multidisciplinary: People from different disciplines working together, each drawing on their disciplinary knowledge.



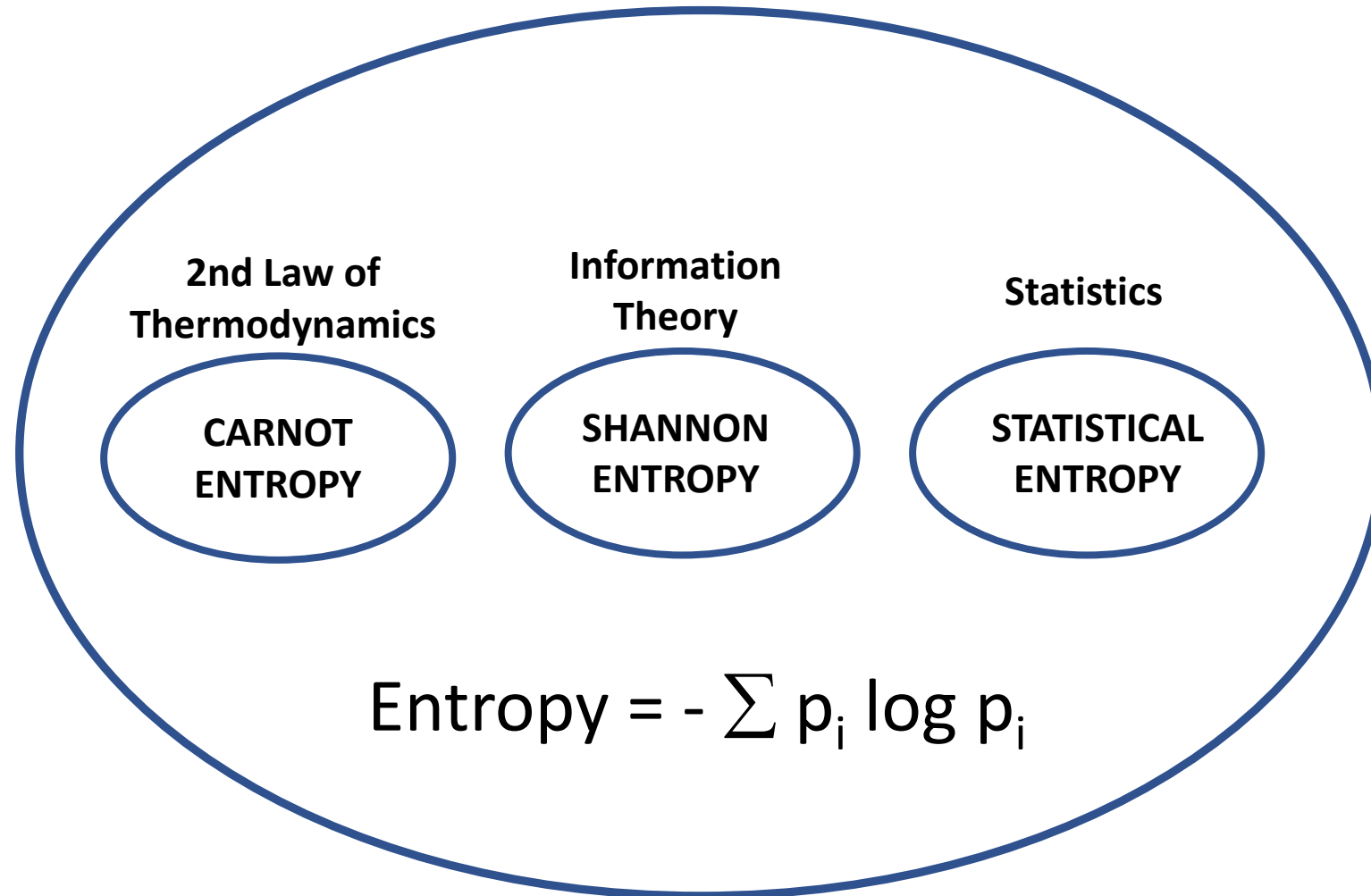
INTERDISCIPLINARY
